Introduction

The Specialty Specific Questions have been developed to test trainee's access to, participation in or confidence in the attainment of specific aspects of the specialty training curriculum.

The questions have been included as Programme Specific Questions in the annual GMC National Trainee Survey. A table showing trainee's collective responses from a national perspective, a comparison with the responses last previously received for the question (if it has been asked in a previous year) and the region or regions where agreement is highest or lowest are shown on pages 3-5 with a fuller breakdown of the questions and the trainee responses (nationally, by Deanery/LETB and by grade later in this report.

173 Palliative Medicine trainees (46 ST3, 42 ST4, 45 ST5, 39 ST6 and 1 ST7 trainee) an overall decrease of 5% compared to 2016, completed the 2017 survey. The numbers of trainees in each Deanery / LETB completing the survey were as follows:




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
Q1. To what extent do you agree or disagree with the following statement? My training to date has prepared me to manage patients independently out of hours.









Q2. To what extent do you agree or disagree with the following statement? There have been adequate opportunities for me to develop my leadership skills in the NHS, over the course of my training.






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
Q3. To what extent do you agree or disagree with the following statement? There have been adequate opportunities for me to develop my leadership skills in the voluntary sector, over the course of my training.












Q4. To what extent do you agree or disagree with the following statement? I am confident in planning and delivering a range of educational sessions.







Q8. In your last on-call weekend, how many unplanned face to face assessments/admissions did you undertake of unstable patients?






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
Q9. In your last on-call weekend, how many times did you give advice, without face-to-face assessment, to another clinical team in the hospital and/or the community?












10. To what extent do you agree or disagree with the following statement? I feel I've had sufficient on-call experience managing unstable patients.







Q11. Please indicate how much you agree or disagree with the following statement: I feel that I can make an informed choice about the type of consultant post I would like to obtain.


