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Introduction

The Specialty Specific Questions have been developed to test trainee's access to, participation in or confidence in the attainment of specific aspects of the specialty training curriculum.

The questions have been included Programme Specific Questions in the annual GMC National Trainee Survey. The details of these questions and the trainee responses (nationally, by Deanery/LETB and by grade can be found within this report.

63 Rehabilitation Medicine trainees (16 ST3, 15 ST4, 9 ST5 and 23 ST6 trainees) completed the 2017 survey. This was a decrease of 3% (2 trainees) compared to 2016. The numbers of trainees in each Deanery / LETB completing the survey were as follows:










Q6. Since starting your programme, how many formal management meetings at the level of your department/division or higher have you attended?










Q7. Since starting your programme, how many visits have you been on to see and assess a patient in their own home? (including residential care home)




Q8. Since starting your programme, how many formal teaching sessions to more than 10 professional colleagues, with formal feedback, have you undertaken?
