

## Specialty Certificate Examination (SCE) in Neurology 2016 Selected Examination Metrics

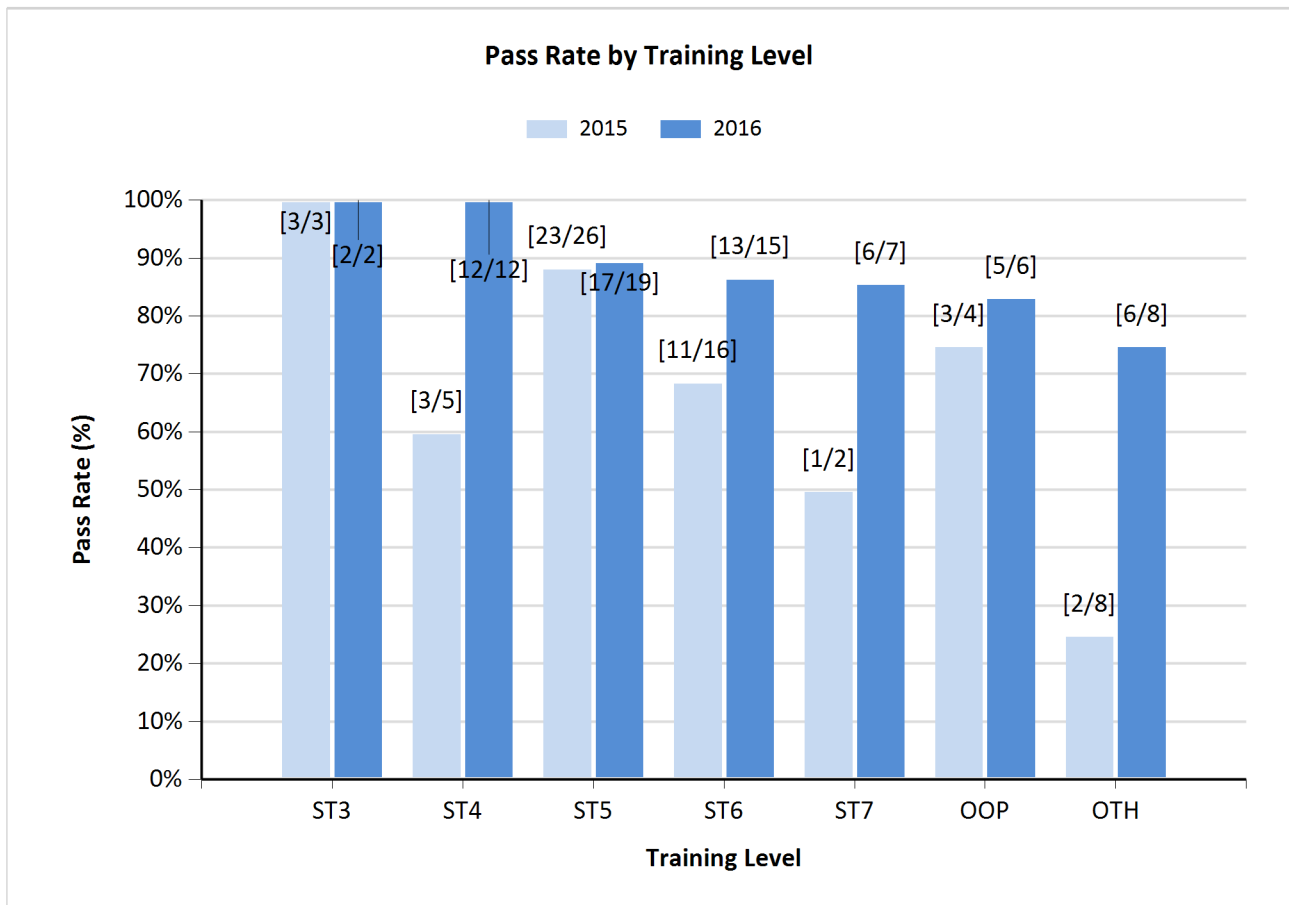
The 2016 SCE in Neurology was sat by 125 candidates of which 69 were self-declared UK trainees. Candidates who did not declare their training details are reported as 'Other' (56).

### Pass Mark

The pass mark for this examination was established by using the Hofstee compromise method which combines the mean scores of the standard setting group with UK trainees' performance.

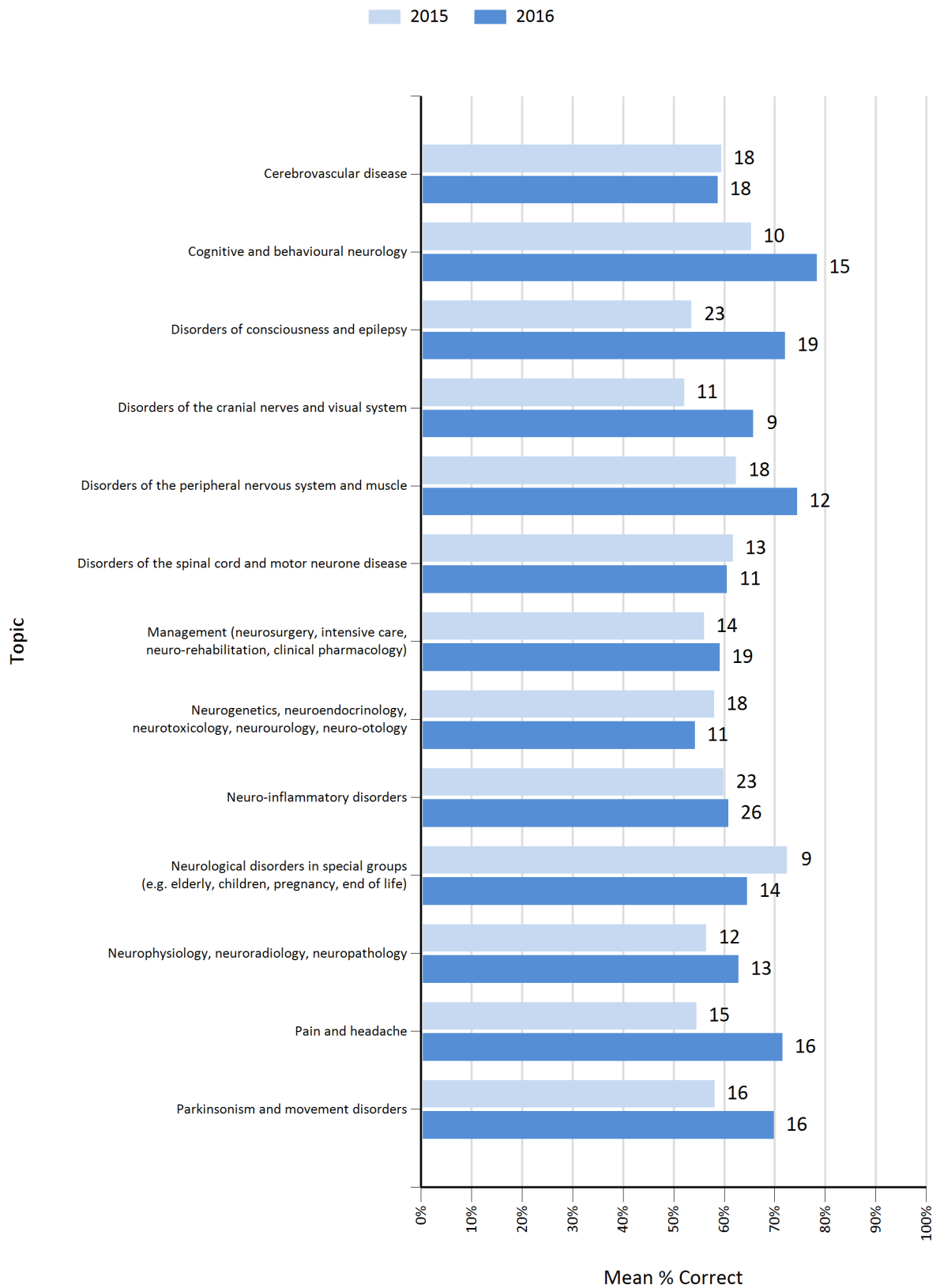
For the 2016 Neurology examination the pass mark was set at 56% (111/199).

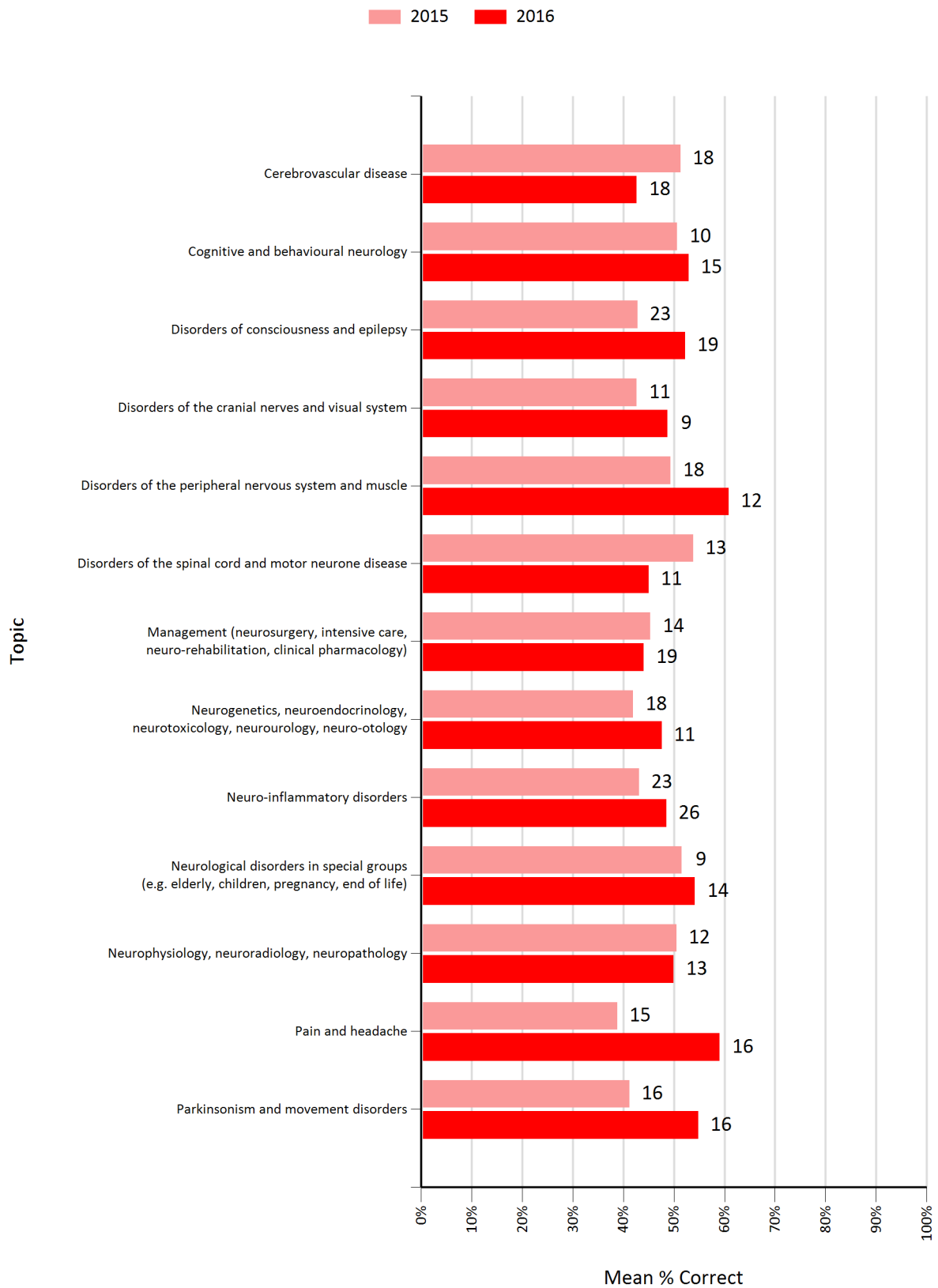
