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Introduction

The Specialty Specific Questions have been developed to test trainee's access to, participation in or confidence in the attainment of specific aspects of the specialty training curriculum.

The questions have been included as Programme Specific Questions in the annual GMC National Trainee Survey. A table showing trainee's collective responses from a national perspective, a comparison with the responses last previously received for the question (if it has been asked in a previous year) and the region or regions where agreement is highest or lowest are shown on pages 2-3. The table on page 4 shows the percentage of trainees in each region in agreement with the question asked in 2018 with a comparison to the percentage in agreement in 2017.




Q12. Which, if any, of the following have you gained direct experience of during the course of your training? (tick all that apply)
