Introduction




Specialty Specific Questions have been developed to test trainee's access to, participation in or confidence in the attainment of specific aspects of the specialty training curriculum and these are included in the annual GMC National Trainee Survey. Overall, agreement decreased in seven of the eight Genitourinary Medicine specialty specific questions compared with 2017.








2) How would you rate your training in ocular inflammation?




3) How would you rate your training in neuro-ophthalmology?






4) How would you rate your training in medical retina?






5) How would you rate your training in laser procedures?






6) How would you rate your training in intravitreal injections?






7) How would you rate your training in the medical modules?






8) How many patients do you see on average in an ophthalmology outpatient clinic?




9) How would you rate your opportunities in research?
